ADDENDUM No. 1 - REVISION No. 1 Statement of Work May 3, 2019

Bellefonte Borough received a Department of Environmental Protection Section 902 grant pertaining to recycling. With the previous grant, the Borough purchased a tractor and windrow turner to periodically turn the compost comprised of leaves and grass. With this grant, the Borough plans to excavate a 300' length X 130' width parcel of ground at its Musser Lane Composting Site in Spring Township. The Borough shall clear the site; prep the subgrade and fine grade; add 4 inches of 2A stone to the subbase and compact the layer of stone. This work will complete the pad for paving by no later than July 15, 2019. There shall be a \$200.00 per day penalty assessed for work not completed by September 30, 2019.

The Contractor shall, between July 15, 2019 and September 30, 2019, perform the following:

- 1. Provide all labor, materials and equipment to install a 25 mm base course bituminous asphalt paving 4 inch compacted over the 300'X 130' stone base established by Bellefonte Borough.
- 2. Install a 9.5 mm wearing course bituminous asphalt paving 1.5 inch compacted on top of the base.
