Proclamation
Honoring Caleb S. Frazier
Eagle Scout Recipient

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bellefonte, a place for families in the heart of Centre County, takes pride in its sense of community and citizen involvement; and

WHEREAS, the vision of the Boy Scouts of America is to prepare every eligible youth in America to become responsible, participating citizens and leaders, who are guided by the Scout Oath and Law; and

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America encourage Eagle Scout candidates to complete worthy projects to improve their neighborhoods, their community and the region; and

WHEREAS, Caleb S. Frazier, a senior at Bellefonte Area High School, is a member of Boy Scout Troop No. 66; and

WHEREAS, Caleb received the rank of Eagle Scout on November 19, 2022.

WHEREAS, this is the highest award a scout can receive; few boys move up through the ranks of scouting and only about 2% make it all the way to Eagle; and

WHEREAS, for his community service project, Caleb planned, purchased and executed the assembly of a doorway and multiple security devices to demonstrate a system that could be installed for protection from an intruder. He then assembled 24 locks of two lengths which were donated to an undisclosed nonprofit organization in Bellefonte, to use as they see fit.; and

WHEREAS, Caleb's persistent progress through the ranks to achieve this prestigious award demonstrates his determination to prepare himself for a meaningful, productive role in society.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Buddy Johnson, Mayor of Borough of Bellefonte, do hereby honor Caleb S. Frazier of Boy Scout Troop No. 66 on his achievement of attaining the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest rank in Boy Scouts.
