Proclamation
Honoring Samuel Henry
Eagle Scout Recipient

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bellefonte, a place for families in the heart of Centre County, takes pride in its sense of community and citizen involvement; and

WHEREAS, the vision of the Boy Scouts of America is to prepare every eligible youth in America to become responsible, participating citizens and leaders, who are guided by the Scout Oath and Law; and

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America encourage Eagle Scout candidates to complete worthy projects to improve their neighborhoods, their community and the region; and

WHEREAS, Samuel Henry, a junior at Bellefonte Area High School, is a member of Boy Scout Troop No. 34; and

WHEREAS, Samuel received the rank of Eagle Scout on September 11, 2022.

WHEREAS, Samuel's persistent progress through the ranks to achieve this prestigious award demonstrates his determination to prepare himself for a meaningful, productive role in society.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Buddy Johnson, Mayor of Borough of Bellefonte, do hereby honor Samuel Henry of Boy Scout Troop No. 34 on his achievement of attaining the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest rank in Boy Scouts.
