Overall Objective of Job:

To cost effectively perform advanced water treatment procedures in order to meet or exceed Department of Environmental Protection water standards.

Essential Functions of Job:

- Operate a wide range of wastewater treatment plant equipment, including but not limited to: raw sewage pumps, diaphragm pumps, screens, compressors, aeration tanks, and centrifugal blowers, hoists, steam cleaners, conveyors, dump trucks, skid steer, frontend loaders and power hand tools;
- Perform laboratory tests including but not limited to: pH tests, water transparency;
- Operate a variety of test equipment and analyzers such as bench and field meters and probes, visual inspection of samplers, weighing trucks and monitoring and sampling septage discharges, and keeping accurate records;
- Perform wastewater procedures, including skimming debris from wastewater tanks and visual inspection of the chemical precipitation processes, operating sludge dewatering equipment;
- Routinely monitor SCADA system and all tank levels, the dissolved oxygen levels and pressure readings from utility water tank;
- Clean and maintain all treatment plant equipment and the facility in a neat and orderly fashion, including plowing snow, blowing snow and minor snow shoveling and minor landscaping;
- Conduct occasional plant tours for the general public when necessary:
- Evaluate all plant processes; in the event of any operational change you must seek prior approval from Asst. Plant Superintendent or Plant Superintendant.
- Record all operational changes in the operator log;
- Other duties as assigned.
