**<u>DEPARTMENT NOTES:</u>** (Significant non-routine types of incidents, just a sample of a few, briefdescription of the incident and outcome)

\*\*This is traditionally the time of year when pedestrian traffic begins to increase, not only the downtown area, but also in the neighborhoods. Motorists are reminded and advised to slow down, especially during low light, adverse weather, and while traveling in residential areas where pedestrians tend to frequent. Most of the roadways in the Borough are legally set at 25mph. There are many of these roadways located in areas where conditions exist (pedestrians, pubic events, narrow roadways, etc) that makes the legal speed hazardous. Drive safe, drive slow, pay attention to the roadway and conditions which may be hazardous at the normal speed limit. This can be a violation of the PA Motor Vehicle Code, "Driving too fast for conditions", or "Safe Speed"

- \*\*Motorists are required to stop for pedestrians which are located within a crosswalk, regardless the pedestrians location within that crosswalk. Ie. if the pedestrian's crossing is almost completed, the traffic furthest away still must stop.
- \*\*Pedestrians are required to wait for a break in traffic before entering the crosswalk.
- \*\*Pedestrians cannot enter a crosswalk without making sure that it is safe to do so. le.
- \*\*pedestrians cannot impede the normal flow of traffic and expect a safe crossing. This is also a violation of the vehicle code and an unsafe act.

  Pedestrians who are not using a crosswalk to cross a public street is generally not a vehicle code violation, however a violation exists if a vehicle must stop for a pedestrian who is NOT using the crosswalk.

\* Information provided to the hot line goes a long way in assisting the Task Force investigations. No information is considered too small or insignificant. Some of the largest investigations which led to an arrest / prosecution, began as hot line information which was " seemingly small." A community partnership is needed to address the current illicit drug issues facing today's society.

### <u>Use of Force:</u> (how many and brief description of each)

Male was arrested for open lewdness. When officers were placing restraints on him, he physically resisted their efforts. Officers used open hand techniques to maintain him. Once handcuffed, officers attempted to place the subject into the patrol vehicle. He kicked the door open and attempted to flee. Again officers used enough force necessary to place him back into the vehicle. No force was used in excess. No injuries were sustained by the subject or officers.
