- * CVS, Smoker's Express and Happy Wraps all were victims of counterfeit money being used. \$50.00 bills were used in all cases. Under investigation
- * A two year child abuse investigation ended in an arrest and extradition (from Colorado) of a 36 year old male who had been sexually assaulting two children for several years. Currently in Jail waiting for trial
- * Vehicle Theft. A male from New York arrested and extradited for stealing an automobile from a Bellefonte resident. Currently in Jail waiting for Trial
- **** Both of the above individual have a history of committing crimes in the Borough
- * Fraud- local Bank had two fraudulent checks presented to them in the amount of \$5,455.00. These were payroll checks. Involved and complex case under investigation
- * Officers were sent to assist a person who was suicidal. The subject wanted the officer to shoot him. He was agitated and told the officer that he should handcuff him because he was thinking about harming the officer. The officer handcuffed him and took him to the hospital. While in route the subject became extremely violent and began striking his head against the rear window. In the end he was safely handed over to the hospital security and staff.
- * On patrol officer stopped a group of youth after curfew. Their parents were contacted to pick them up.
- * On foot patrol officer located that the Gamble Mill was left unsecure. Officer checked the building interior and secured it.
- * Officer sent to the Omar Bar for a woman who was having anxiety about walking home. On scene she told the officer that she was scared to walk home. The officer gave her the safest route and stated that he would keep an eye on her. Officer shadowed her home and watched her go into her residence from his vehicle.
