DEPARTMENT NOTES: (Significant non-routine types of incidents, just a sample of a few, brief description of the incident and outcome)

**Officers were serving a mental health warrant on an individual (for the 3rd time in a one month period), when the individual started to be combative, kicking and striking the officer. The officer was able to gain control over the person and transported to the hospital without any injury to the subject.

**Officer called to a theft of a motorcycle complaint. Victim motorcycle collector was shopping on-line for a vintage collectible motorcycles when he noticed one of his for sale locally. He checked his collection and noticed that particular M.C. was missing. Investigation concluded, charges to be filed for theft.

**Threat of possible wide -spread school related violence State-wide. BPD had a high visible presence at all school buildings within the Borough and coordinated with other agencies for same at other District buildings outside of the Borough. No incidents took place.

**Officers dealt with an individual experiencing a mental health crisis. Individual was threatening suicide . After an intense few hours the officer was able to negotiate with the subject. Officer transported the aggressive patient to the hospital without any physical harm to anyone. Although the subject was agitated and aggressive, officer was able to calm the subject using crisis intervention techniques.

** School Resource officer was called to the Elementary School for a report of a student actively acting out in a violent manner. Child was throwing various objects at emotional support staff. Most of the deescalation techniques were not working. The SRO was able to regain control and resolve the situation by using his training and quick thinking. No one was injured during this event.

**Officer investigated a stalking case in which a woman was leaving a relationship. The male par of this began to become aggressive and started to mentally torment her.

He began to follow her in public places, threaten her life, and used other types of mental coercion. Officer was able to provide victim with the appropriate resources and information for victim services. Furthermore, officer was able to resolve the situation. The other half of this was able obtain a professional mental health evaluation.

Use of Force: (how many and brief description of each)

There were two incidents in which officers had to use physical force to subdue individuals. .

1. mental health patient kicked and struck officer. Officer used open hand techniques to handcuff and subdue. No injuries sustained
2. Domestic violence arrestee fled from officers. Officer chased subject on foot, TAZER displayed, subject was taken into custody , open hand techniques,no injuries to anyone.

Officers conducted foot patrols downtown during the Victorian Christmas events. Day and night shifts alike. Officers crossed pedestrians at downtown intersections.

Officers handed out food packages that were put together by several agencies in Center County to include all Law enforcement agencies in the County.
