DEPARTMENT NOTES: (Significant non-routine types of incidents, just a sample of a few, brief description of the incident and outcome)

* Report of a vehicle driving erratically on the Benner Pike heading towards Bellefonte. Officer located the vehicle on Blanchard St. After a traffic stop and a field investigation, the driver was not intoxicated, rather having difficulty driving at night. Officer requested a driver's recertification exam for the operator.

* Officers received a dispatch for people being attacked with guns and knives at the VFW. Officers responded and found the night time janitor cleaning alone. This was a false report, the caller was out of Allegheny County. There were no records of who called in the complaint.

*Officer was on routine patrol when she noticed a person standing on the sidewalk near the Dollar General store. She knew that he had warrants out of Centre County. She stopped and served the warrant on him. While patting down the subject she found marijuana and suspected methamphetamine on his person. He was taken to CCCF for the warrant. The suspected drugs were sent to the PSP crime lab for analysis prior to arrest being filed.

* Two male High School students got into a fight in the boys bathroom. Both struck each other in the facial area. Both were cited by the SRO for disorderly conduct.

* A male teenager was dropping off people at the YMCA after school. When he was leaving he accelerated hard, spinning his tires which caused smoke and a loud noise. The responding officer was given a name. The officer chose to have the SRO bring him into his office and have a talk with him to deter future incidents, and for him to apologize to the YMCA.

We reached out to mental health for them to evaluate and or offer the subject some help. MHR did respond to his residence and evaluated him. They offered him assistance in which he was very receptive of. He was found not to be suicidal or a threat to anyone else, however he was in need of treatment.

* A Spring Township officer was investigating Domestic Violence complaint. A female walked into her station reporting that she was attacked by her paramour. As this was the first time that the SPTPD officer investigated a DV case, two of our officers assisted her with interviewing the victim. The officers also assisted with taking the male suspect into custody for an arrest.
