**DEPARTMENT NOTES:** (Significant non-routine types of incidents, just a sample of a few, brief description of the incident and outcome)

\* A person was watching a male/female argument on N. Penn St. The female was screaming and the male stated that he was going to get his rifle. On scene the male was taken into custody for an active warrant. The rifle was located in his vehicle. They are currently in the process of divorce. Victim services information was given to the female. Male taken to jail.

\* While on foot patrol, night shift officer found the Court House Annex building to be unsecured. Officer checked the building, nothing out of the ordinary found. Officer secured the doors.

\* Officers noticed a female standing near Confer's Jewelry Store wearing nothing but a bath towel. Officers facilitated in her getting dressed and taken to MNMC for an evaluation.

\* Officers served a 302 ( involuntary) mental health warrant on an individual. This individual has a lengthy history of mental health issues. Has acted out in violence towards Police in prior incidents of 302 warrants. Warrant served without struggle.

\* Officer was approached by a male who identified himself as a DEA agent. He was trying to give information to the officer. Officer requested the individual for identification. He could not provide any, nor any information to verify that he was DEA. He was later cited for public drunk. Charges for impersonating a L.E. officer pending.

\* Officer was giving field sobriety tests to an individual, officer located a loaded firearm on his person and another handgun in the vehicle. Also, drugs and drug paraphernalia were located. Arrested for DUI /drugs.

\* A person parked along the Court House, went inside and came back out 20 minutes to find his wallet on the ground with all money missing. Officer noticed video cameras on court house. Ultimately video footage clearly identified the woman who took the wallet, and money. Officers caught up with her and confronted her. Victim got his money back.

Officers responded to a person trying to gain entry into an apartment on North Allegheny St. On scene, we stopped an individual fitting the description of the suspect. It was determined that he had active warrants in Centre County. Search upon arrest yielded a bag of powdery substance which tested positive for methamphetamine. Taken to CC Jail for probation detainer and arraigned on my drug charges.

\* Third party report of a domestic dispute at the Bell Tower apartments. On scene, officer were directed to the residence in question. Officer could hear a loud argument between a man and woman. Just as it started to escalate, officer announced his presence and waited for the door to open. Back up arrived and the male was ordered outside while the other officer spoke with the female half. It was determined that it was all verbal with some breaking of items. Although no arrest made, female was given information on how to utilize the WRC and victim services for assistance. Male was warned to open door immediately next time when an officer identifies himself. This is for everyone's safety.
