**DEPARTMENT NOTES:** (Significant non-routine types of incidents, just a sample of a few, brief description of the incident and outcome)

\*Officers were given a 302 ( mental health warrant) for a person who was having an emotional crisis. Officers made contact with the individual at their residence. They were able to talk the person into going voluntarily. Officers gave the subject a ride to Mt. Nittany Medical Center and let her into the care of the hospital. No issues

\* A person on probation had to take a urinalysis test for a drug screen in the Probation Office. He attempted to provide false urine. Officer took false urine into evidence and filed criminal charges.

\* Officer on patrol witnessed an operator get out of her vehicle and began yelling at another operator. Officer stopped to intervene. The yelling operator said that the other driver almost struck a pedestrian. There was some confusion as to what took place. In the end the officer spoke with both of them and kindly advised both of a better way to take care of the situation as both people needed to correct something about their actions.

\* Officer was dispatched to go to a local bank to stop a Benner Twp. resident from taking \$19,000.00 from his account and sending it to the requester. It was an apparent scam that he believed to be true. Officer located him before the guy made his withdrawal. Prevented the scam from working.

\* A 73 year old male had not been seen in his apartment complex for 4 days. Friends called to report that this was very odd and that he never would miss a Doctor's appointment. Officer found out the last place that he was supposed to be going to was his family camp/cabin well outside of our coverage area. Officers contacted relatives who in turn went out to the camp. They found him in the front yard deceased. Officer told them to contact PSP right away and to not touch anything or disturb the area.

\* 400 block of Cherry Lane, someone damaged a residents parked vehicle by throwing a heavy paver onto its roof causing moderate damage. Officer noted a surveillance camera close by. Made contact with the owner of the camera. It did not record anything of usefulness to this case.

\* Responded to the emergency room for an assault that took place in town earlier. A male told officer that he was visiting a friend in town. At his place his friend began instigating him into a fight. He was trying to leave when he was stuck from behind in his ribs. Ribs were fractured. He wishes prosecution. Noted that this same person broke his jaw last year and wished not to have his friend charged. Medical release signed, charges to be filed

\* Report of a fight between two males in progress with mention of a knife involved. Spring Twp. officers also arrived with BPD. One male was injured and ended up in a bathtub as a result of the fight. Officers able to determine there was no knife used or displayed by anyone. Citations issued.

**Use of Force:** (how many and brief description of each)

There were no incidents of USE of FORCE by Bellefonte PD in September.

\* Domestic, male vs. female. On scene determined that the older female would not let the younger male leave so she started hitting him. This is ongoing and that every time she gets mad at him, she strikes him and wont let him leave. She admitted to this. She was cited for harassment. The neighbors are getting quite upset with all of the high level of noise. She was warned for final time about the noise and cited.
