<u>DEPARTMENT NOTES:</u> (Significant-non-routine types of incidents, just a sample of a few, brief description of the incident and outcome)

- * While on routine vehicle patrol, a civilian vehicle ran a stop sign and struck a police officer driving through an intersection. No injuries to the civilian or officer. Police car was totaled.
- * Male struck his son several times in the facial area, casing bruising, swelling and cut lips. Son and daughter were taken into protective custody by officers. Father was arrested and put into CCCF with refusal of bail by the Judge
- *A white male has been seen at Governor's park every day in a blue vehicle. Reported as suspicious as he is cooking each day. Officers made contact with him. He is homeless. He stays in a parking lot out of the Borough in the evenings and comes in to the park to cook and hang out during the day. No problems out of him. Made attempt to help him find housing.
- * Juvenile female arguing with her mother, verbal fighting. She attempted to run away however the officer subdued her before she got away.
- * Child abuse- father accused of getting into a physical confrontation with his son because he allegedly stole tools from his father. CYS called to investigate with P.D. assisting.
- ** Civil issue. Tenant said that they made a rent payment by placing cash under his door mat. Landlord stated that he never got it. Explained to complainant that there was nothing that could be done at it was a civil issue and one of a credibility judgment
- * Officer met with several community members at Governor's park apartments. Officer gave out handouts and explained their purpose and how to reach the officer if needed.
- * Different officer conducted the same type of program at Beaver Farm Lane apartments.
- * We are still getting several reports of identify thefts, unemployment claims being made falsely in victim's names.

* Intense altercation between 4 roommates that were leaving the apartment in the near future. Two couples were fighting over property and who owned what. Officers intervened and turned out to have a safe ending as there were several weapons present to include a handgun, and a large heavy digging bar. Emotions were running high and was a very volatile situation. Deescalation in place.

A juvenile female tried to run away from her mother and officer. Officer grabbed her by the arm and subdued her calmly.
