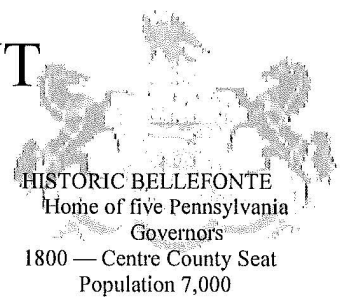

**DEPARTMENT NOTES:** (Significant non-routine types of incidents, just a sample of a few, brief description of the incident and outcome)

- \*Two BPD officers tested positive for COVID 19. Both are currently back on duty
- \*One BPD officer will be having surgery on Friday the 12th. If all goes well, the officer will be back on duty in mid April.
- \*Tip of an underage drinking party on Reynolds Ave. 5 juveniles were cited for underage consumption, one had a controlled substance. All juveniles were released to a sober adult/parent.
- \* Domestic disturbance where a father was being slapped in the face by his daughter. She was having suicidal thoughts and emotional stress. Officer spoke with her and convinced her into having a mental health evaluation. Officer took her to the hospital and released her into the care of MNMC.
- \* Female Jr. High student having a crisis, Officer assisted in getting her to the hospital where she was evaluated for having explicit suicidal thoughts and plans.
- \* While on routine patrol, officer witnessed a pedestrian walking into traffic unlawfully, causing a vehicle to stop abruptly. Officer stopped pedestrian and advised how to properly and safely cross a busy roadway.
- \* Officers provided Internet Safety courses to each elementary school classes
- \* Overdose on North Wilson Street. Male using heroin went unresponsive with no pulse. Narcan was given with negative results, he was revived seconds later by medics and Police.
- \* School Resource officer was requested immediately to assist the Elementary School Principal. She had a very unruly and combative student in her office. Officer arrived and took control over the situation which deescalated soon after the officer requested compliance in an "authoritative" way.
- \* Night time patrol officers issued 68 "alternate side" parking tickets in January
